Advertise helpful community information such as grocery sales or road closures.

Advertise legitimate job offers if you are the individual doing the hiring. This could be a service in your house such as landscaping or a position in your company that pays a wage.

Post community services and resources.

Advertise free pets.

Ask community members to recommend a professional like a dentist or plumber. You cannot post unsolicited advertisements for such.

Inquire about rooms or apartments to rent or homes for sale/rent in our community.

Community Safety Guidelines

To maintain a safe and comfortable community for all, we have the following restrictions:

- You cannot promote a position in a Multi-Level Marketing company or other opportunities that do not offer hourly wages.
- You can NOT proselyte. You cannot post political commentary. You cannot solicit for your business or ask for money for any reason.
- You cannot offer classes as a ploy to introduce your business or product. No "strings-attached" offerings allowed.
